

NORTH CAROLINA RISK MANAGEMENT CREDENTIALING 2009

Re-certifying Your Risk Management

If you want to officiate NCASA adult or NCYSA youth or USYS youth matches, in North Carolina, or nationally, you must voluntarily undergo a criminal background check. ***You must re-submit a Risk Management Registration Application every year between August 01 and August 31.***

If your Risk Management Expiration Date is 04/01/2009, you must go back online and submit a new on line Risk management Registration Application by 04/01/2009.

If your Risk Management Expiration date is 08/31/2009, you must go back online and submit a new Risk Management Registration Application by 08/01/2009.

How do I find my Risk Management expiration date?

The Arbiter. Go into your account in the Arbiter and click on "Misc Fields" and the fourth row down will show you your Risk Management Expiration date.

There is no charge to you for the background check.

To complete the simple background check questionnaire, please follow these steps:

1. Go to the NCYSA web page at www.ncsoccer.org
2. On the right margin menu, in blue, click on "Risk Management"
3. Click on "Click Here..."
4. On the main Risk Management Application page, check the second item entitled, "**I have never submitted a Risk Management registration form to NCYSA before.**"
5. Follow the instructions on completing the questionnaire, and then click submit.
6. Wait... Don't leave the site... You'll receive a confirmation number... Then...
7. Be sure to complete the second part of the questionnaire that asks you to identify ALL the *positions* you hold within the NC soccer community. (e.g. "referee" and/or "referee assignor" and/or "referee instructor" and/or "referee administrator" and/or "coach"...)
